

The next meeting will be Tuesday, September 11th at 7pm. The September meeting will be held at the fairgrounds. At this meeting, we will be nominating officers for 2018. The slate will be voted on at the October meeting.

Anniversary Show

Several reminders about the Anniversary show being held September 22-23:

- 1. There will be a meal on Saturday night. The cost for members ages 7 and up is \$5. The cost for non-members ages 7 and up is \$7. For all children 6 and under, there will be a kids meal (hot dog, chips, drink) for \$3. The adult menu is: pork loin, chicken and noodles, mashed potatoes and gravy, green beans, and tossed green salad.
- 2. Tickets for the dinner will be available for purchase at the entry booth during the show on Saturday.
- 3. The meal Saturday night will be catered. Valley will be providing an Anniversary Cake for dessert. Members are asked to bring another dessert to share.
- 4. Don't forget to work your hours so that you are eligible for year-end awards. Please call Barb this week to sign up for a time slot to work. Please don't wait until the October show to try to work your hours—there may not be enough jobs to go around!
- 5. If you have not sent in your check for your stall reservation, please contact Debbi to get added to the list. We have a few stalls still available. Remember your normal stall reservation doesn't count for this show! Stalls are prepaid and need to be reserved ahead of time, members and non-members!
- 6. Don't forget about the special events on Saturday night: dog costume, dog race, egg toss, and *NEW THIS YEAR-CORNHOLE TOURNAMENT.*.
- 7. Don't forget that the show will be double judged on Saturday, and single judged on Sunday! Trail will be held only on Saturday--3 separate judges, no trail on Sunday. This is being done in an effort to get things done quicker!
