**NOVICE RIDER ENG/WEST PLEASURE: Rider never placing 1st in a class of 3 or more 4 times in the last 5 years in an English or Western Pleasure class in any Breed, 4-H or Open Show.

**NOVICE SHOWMANSHIP: Exhibitor never placing 1st in a class of 3 or more 4 times in the last 5 years in a Showmanship class in any Breed, 4-H or Open Show.

***SCHOOLING CLASSES: Safe attire = long pants, boots with heel, and appropriate headgear. Year end awards are not given in schooling classes.

++ Exhibitors who are 50 & over may show in the 50 & over class OR the corresponding 19 & over class but not both classes of the same type.

CLASSES: 14, 16, 19, 34 & 37 Trophy & ribbons - No payback
